Irish Traveller Movement in Britain (ITMB) was established in November 1999 as a second tier community development charity.

It successfully gained charitable status as a national community development, policy and voice organisation in 2003.

ITMB act as a bridge builder bringing the Traveller communities, service providers and policy makers together, thereby stimulating debate and promoting forward-looking strategies to promote increased race equality, civic engagement, inclusion, service provision and community cohesion.

ITMB is a national organisation which works with Irish Travellers, raising their profile and helping them to influence policy.

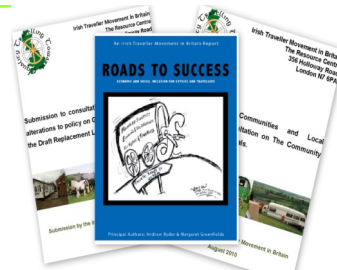
What is the Support Engagement Services?

ITMB Support and Engagement Services is our way of responding to the gaps in service provision for Britain's Traveller communities. We do this by providing a wide range of support and recourses to the communities and various service providers.

Research and Consultancy

ITMB work in partnership with universities and stakeholder groups to produce a wide range of evidence based research. We undertake specific commissions from local authorities. Some of these commissions include mapping exercises, needs analysis and community consultations.

ITMB provide expert advice and support on a wide range of issues relating to your work with Traveller Communities. We also provide expert advice, coaching and mentoring to statutory groups. We can make a valuable contribution by participating in a wide range of advisory groups.



Training

We provide cost effective training to suit the service providers' specific needs. All our training programmes can be tailored to suit your local needs. An example of some of the training we deliver includes Community Engagement, Cultural Awareness and development of services to the Traveller Communities.

Interagency Forums and Networking
